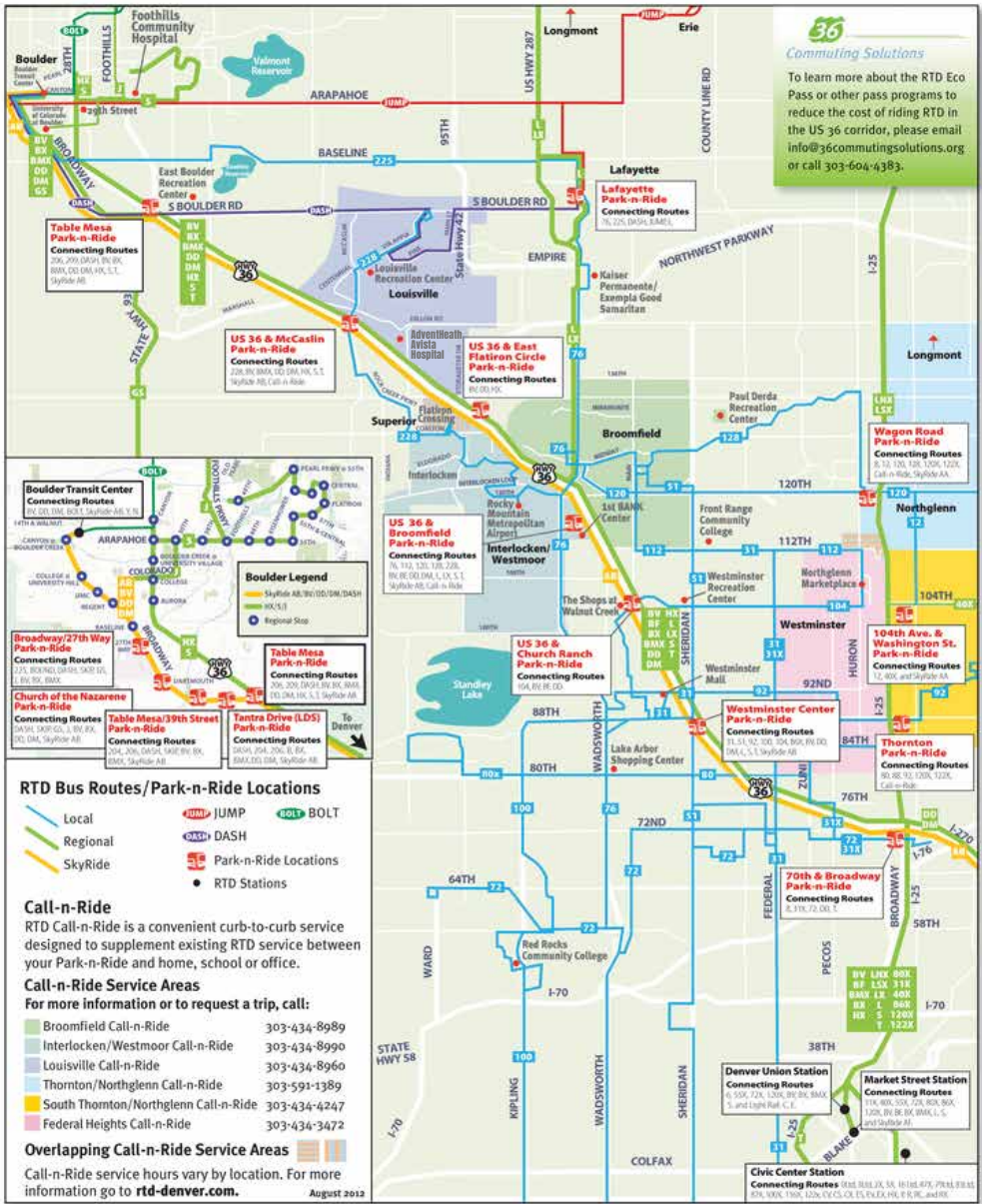

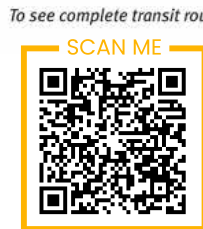

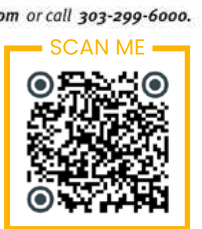
US36 Interactive Bikeway Map

HISTORY OF SUPERIOR

It's difficult to fathom the breathtaking view that Charles and Emeline Hake encountered when they first laid eyes on the Coal Creek Valley. Back in 1860, what is now known as the **Town of Superior** consisted of merely a handful of European pioneers. Nestling themselves alongside Coal Creek in what is now Original Town Superior, the Hakes embarked on acquiring land from the U.S. Government and the railroads, building a thriving farming legacy with an eye toward the future.

In 1892, Charles Hake stumbled upon coal reserves beneath the ground. This discovery led to the establishment of the Industrial Mine in 1896, and in that same year, Hake laid out a town site. He sold plots of land and marketed the coal as having "no superior in the state," thus giving birth to the town's name - Superior.

A TOWN TRANSFORMED

SUPERIOR THROUGH THE DECADES



Over the following decades, the population of Superior remained relatively modest, with miners and their families settling in the town to work in the coal mines of the Industrial Mine. However, the end of World War II marked the decline of the coal mining era. By the time the Industrial Mine closed its doors in 1945, it had produced nearly 4 million tons of this coveted fuel.

Throughout the subsequent four decades, Superior remained a tranquil and secluded corner of Boulder County, little known to the outside world. Everything changed in the 1990s with the development of a master-planned community by Richmond Homes, known as Rock Creek Ranch. The Town of Superior annexed Rock Creek, leading to significant improvements such as upgraded water and sewer access, as well as paved streets for the Original Superior.

Ever since Rock Creek Ranch revolutionized Superior thirty years ago, the town has experienced extraordinary growth. Despite its modest size of just four square miles, Superior now boasts a population nearing 14,000, along with 630 acres of parks, green space, and an extensive 35-mile trail network.

Superior is a cyclist friendly community with paved trails that connect riders to local destinations and the greater Front Range trail network. Popular routes include the **US 36 Bikeway**, a major paved path linking Superior to Broomfield, Boulder, and beyond and ideal for longer rides and commuters. The **Coal Creek Trail** runs directly through Superior and continues to Louisville and Lafayette, offering flat, easy riding that is perfect for families and those looking to enjoy a relaxed ride through open space.

For riders looking to explore more scenic connections, the **Rock Creek Trail** links into the Coal Creek Trail system and offers beautiful views with a mix of paved and light gravel sections. Together, these trails make Superior an inviting destination for cyclists of all levels who want to enjoy safe, connected routes in a stunning Colorado setting.

EDUCATION IN SUPERIOR



The Town of Superior is part of the **Boulder Valley School District**, which serves more than 30,000 students across 56 schools. Superior is home to two schools: **Superior Elementary** for Kindergarten through fifth grade and **Eldorado** for Kindergarten through eighth grade. High school students attend **Monarch High School** in Louisville.

BVSD also offers an open enrollment policy, allowing families to choose from other district schools when space is available, with transportation provided by parents. Popular options include **Monarch** Kindergarten through eighth grade in Louisville, **Summit Middle Charter School** in Boulder, **Peak to Peak Charter School** in Lafayette, and **Fairview High School** in Boulder.

For early childhood education, families often choose **The Goddard School** in Louisville or **Primrose School at the Flatirons** in Broomfield, a Chamber member. A Faith based education option is **Holy Family High School** in Broomfield.

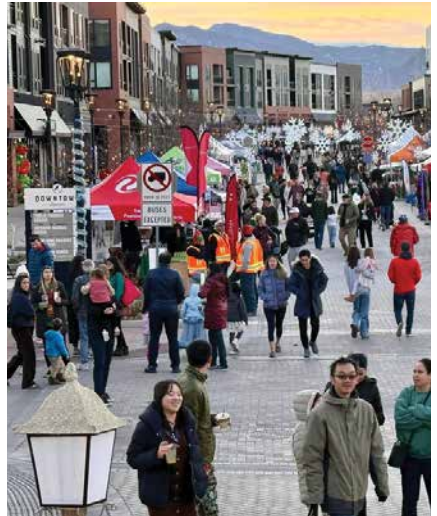

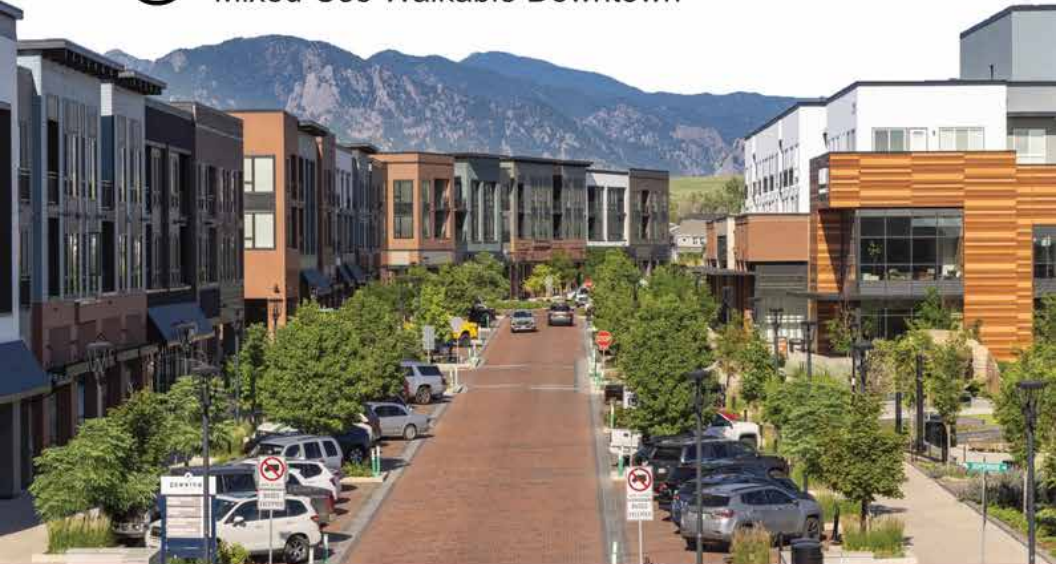
